

How to read the voting data in the images

Once voting is completed, the verified results are encoded into a standardized format. This encoding process ensures that all results are uniform and can be easily integrated into the national database.

Each voting station from an electoral center prints a result tally at the end of the process (see printed tally example to the right). This tally features a QR code (1), which provides quick access to the detailed results of each station. Scanning the QR code can help verify the authenticity of the tally and provide a digital record of the vote count.

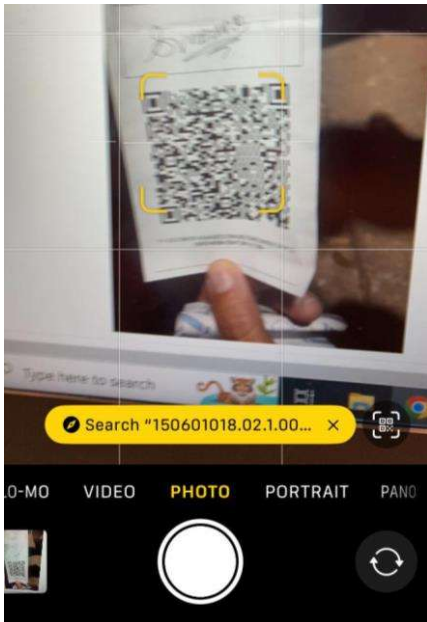
The tally also lists the candidates who participate in the election, and finally, it provides a breakdown of the votes (2).

Follow the three steps below to interpret the information coded in the QR images.

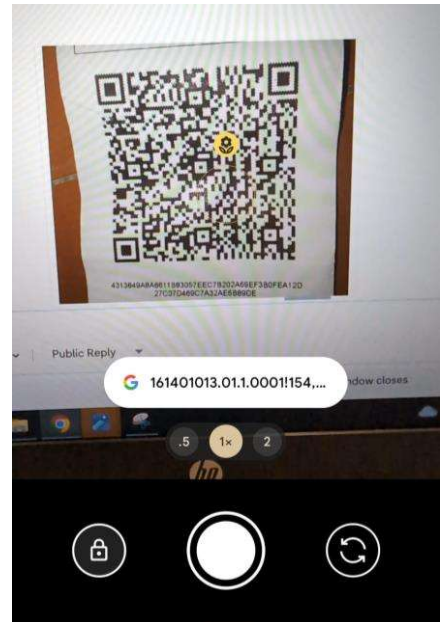

1. **Scan the QR code with your phone device.** When detecting the QR code, search for the number pop-up (in yellow for iPhones or white Google for Android). Tap on it to open an explorer search of that code.

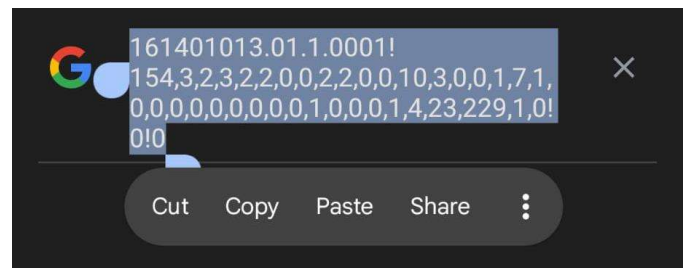


2. **Copy the full code to get the voting data.**

3. Interpret the code to see voting data. The resulting code is broken into the four sections listed below.

Each section is separated by an exclamation mark ("!")	
Section 1	Voting center code, voting table, implementation protocol
Section 2	Votes by the candidate and party affiliation, separated by commas. See details below
Section 3	Total void votes
Section 4	Total partial votes
